This leaves the other half of the day for relaxation, strolling the grounds, swimming in our pool, reading, playing shuffleboard or horseshoes, or joining in the coordinated activity programs. Nightly entertainment rounds off the day.

DAY 1

An afternoon arrival, complete with punch welcome, leaves lots of time to explore the property and grounds. Walk to the nearby gift shops, cheese and ice cream stores, and of course, Skydeck Tower. Enjoy a super dinner at the lodge and a video presentation tonight.

Next comes dinner and our evening's entertainment should have you up on your feet dancing, or just swaying to the music.
